I, Marcia Uhrig, declare under penalty of perjury as follows:

1. I am over the age of 18 and mentally competent. Except where stated on information and belief, I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth herein and if called upon to testify, could and would do so.

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2. I am an Assistant Director of Operations at The Garden City Group, LLC (“GCG”), the Claims and Noticing Agent employed by Victoria L. Nelson, the Chapter 7 Trustee in the above-captioned bankruptcy case.

3. I make this declaration in support of the *Motion For (1) Turnover of Security Deposits Held In Trust Account of McDonald Carano Wilson Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §542 and (2) Authority to Administer Security Deposits Through the Debtor’s Bankruptcy Estate Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 105(a)* (the “Motion”).¹

4. On February 9, 2015, the Trustee filed an *Application for Order Authorizing Employment of Garden City Group, LLC As Claims and Noticing Agent* [ECF No. 88]² (the “Application to Employ GCG”). The Application to Employ GCG sought authority to employ GCG as claims and noticing agent in the Debtor’s bankruptcy case.

5. On February 27, 2015, the Court entered an *Order Authorizing Employment of the Garden City Group, LLC As Claims and Noticing Agent* [ECF No. 128].

6. Since its employment, GCG has been collecting proofs of claim that have been filed in the Debtor’s bankruptcy case.

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

4 case is attached hereto as **Exhibit "1"**.
